Purpose

To represent EYFDM's interests in Wonca Europe Executive Board and support WONCA Europe Executive Board (WE EB) work

Activities

- Bring a trainee and early-career GP views and input into WE EB work.
- Share relevant information from WE EB with EYFDM EB and vice versa

Why

- To ensure the voice of EYFDM is heard in WONCA Europe.
- To ensure representation and advocacy for NFGPs/FDs to externals who are in contact with WE

Duties & Responsibilities

- Commit to a 3 year mandate (Sept 2025 mid 2028)
- Attend regular WE EB monthly online meetings and biannual face to face Spring and Winter meetings.
- Attend annual EYFDM Executive face to face planning meeting
- Attend both the WONCA Europe annual conference and the EYFDM Forum
- Advocate for EYFDM in WE meetings
- Report to EYFDM Executive relevant topics discussed in WE EB and Council
- Report to WE EB on relevant topics discussed in EYFDM Executive and Council
- Be an active member of WE EB, including joining a WE Statutory Committee.
