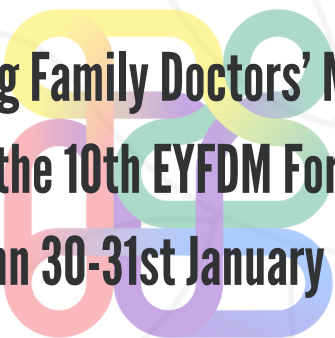




European Young Family Doctors' Movement Fund for the 10th EYFDM Forum Tallinn 30-31st January 2026

BACKGROUND

The EYFDM Fund is one of our oldest initiatives and certainly one of those we are constantly proud of. Since 2012 EYFDM has financially supported dozens of young family physicians across the region and brought them closer to the international community of young general practitioners. The truly inspirational power and strength of EYFDM is based on the diversity of its members. The Fund is committed to enabling EYFDM events to become accessible for those who want to join them.

AIMS

Each member from each country is equally important but there is no equality without equity. EYFDM Fund has been created in order to equalize opportunities of participating in EYFDM events such as EYFDM Preconference, EYFDM Forum and WONCA Europe Conference.

We use the EYFDM Fund especially to support those who have low income, as well as those who are new to EYFDM. We are convinced that participation in the mentioned events can boost the motivation of being a great physician, an active member of EYFDM and build a strong network of young family doctors across the continent. Our goal is to strengthen Primary Care in each country by reinforcing, inspiring and connecting its general practitioners, the EYFDM Fund is one of the means to achieve it.

REFUND

This year we offer **3 bursaries** for the EYFDM Forum in Tallinn.

For each of the **3** EYFDM Fund recipients will be awarded with up to **750€** of reimbursement.

The refund can cover:

- registration fee for the EYFDM Forum in Tallinn 2026
- the cost of flight tickets/ train tickets to EYFDM Forum in Tallinn 2026
- the cost of accommodation during EYFDM Forum in Tallinn 2026
- **one** social event hosted by EYFDM Forum in Tallinn 2026

The early bird registration fee (110 euros) has been already booked for 3 winners.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA

We cannot provide the reimbursement if the EYFDM Fund recipient:

- is not from a country that is within the WONCA Europe region
- lives in Estonia
- fails to prove attendance at the EYFDM Forum in Tallinn
- fails to send a report of her/his experience within one month after the event
- fails to prove the incurred costs
- is a winner of a previous EYFDM fund or scholarship

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant will be asked to describe her/his experience (using 250- 500 words) within one month after attending the event.
- The applicant will be asked to send the proof of incurred costs (e.g.bills, invoices).

The reimbursement will be given up to one month after finalising mentioned above requirements.

CONSENT

By applying for the Fund, the applicant agrees on:

- using her/his photo publicity purposes on the EYFDM social media channels and/or website
- publishing her/his report about the attended events (live and/or virtual) for publicity purposes on the EYFDM social media channels and/or website

The aim of these two consents is to disseminate the value of participation in the mentioned events and raise awareness of the significance of the Fund. The personal data can be omitted at the request of the candidate.
